Quiet Hours vs. The Quiet Season

Quiet hours exist within the Campmeeting during the following times:

- 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday
- 10 p.m. until 7 a,m. Sunday through Thursday
- All day on Sunday

In addition to Quiet Hours, the Quiet Season pertains to the use of high decibel power tools such as leaf blowers and manual work such as framing and roofing. The Quiet Season is all day long (24/7) and extends from July 15 through August 31. Any exceptions must be approved in advance by the Board of Managers.
